Job Description

1) The associate professor or lecturer will teach several courses in each term: Ecological Resources in Rural Regions, Ecology, Field Work on Ecology, Ecology and Conservation of Biodiversity, and the following courses under cooperation with academic staffs of other research fields, Practical Research on Regional Resource Management, Coordinated Management of Regional Resources, Seminar for Regional Resource Management, Practical Science Communication, Advanced Seminar and Research, Other courses related to Ecology

2) The associate professor or lecturer will take charge of the graduate school's research and administrative activities.

3) The associate professor or lecturer will also be appointed a researcher of the department of Ecology, Hyogo Park of the Oriental White Stork. He or She will take charge of the department's research and administrative activities, promoting conservation and reintroduction of the Oriental White Stork.

4) The associate professorship or lectureship will start from 1st April 2019 and last for five years, with

the first six months being a probation period. He or She will be evaluated at five years intervals, and the position can be guaranteed for a further five years, repeatedly before the compulsory retirement age of 65.

Qualifications

All candidates must have a PhD at the time of his/her application. The area of specialization should be Animal Ecology targeting at large birds, including land birds, wading birds and water birds.

They should have strong motivation and potential for conducting researches in the field and teaching students.

They should have strong motivation and enough experience for conducting researches and administrative activities also as a researcher of the department of ecology, Hyogo Park of the Oriental White Stork.

They should have the Japanese language capabilities necessary to teach students in Japanese. Japanese communication skills are also essential for a full communication with people living in Toyooka and its neighboring areas.

Compensation

- 1) Working hours and other working conditions are in conformity with the regulations of University of Hyogo (graduate school of Regional Research Management) on working hours, holidays and vacations. The free time system for professionals is to be applied.
