1	Admissions Capacity & Application Eligibility
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Admissions Capacity Department of Applied Informatics, Graduate School of Applied Informatics:
40 students (including preferred applicants, August applicants and January applicants)
Out of all 40 students, several will be admitted to the Dual-Degree Program

Application Eligibility

(1) General selection

Applicants must meet any of the following requirements.

- ① Individuals who have graduated from universities or those who will graduate from one by March 31, 2015
- ② Individuals who were awarded Bachelor's degrees from the National Institution for Academic Degrees and University Evaluation (NIAD-UE) under Article 104, Paragraph 4 of the School Education Act of Japan, or those who will be awarded such degrees by March 31, 2015
- ③ Individuals who have completed sixteen years of schooling outside of Japan, or those who will complete said schooling by March 31, 2015
- ④ Individuals who have completed sixteen years of schooling in foreign countries through correspondence courses provided by schools in the relevant countries while living in Japan, or those who will complete said schooling by March 31, 2015
- ⑤ Individuals who have completed the university program of a foreign educational institute located in Japan (limited to programs whose graduates are recognized as having completed sixteen years of schooling in relevant foreign countries) authorized by the school education system of relevant foreign countries as those having university programs, and designated separately by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, or those who will complete the said program by March 31, 2015
- ⑥ Individuals who have completed specialized programs from specialized training colleges (limited to programs which satisfy the criteria established by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, such as an enrollment period of four years, which is required for completion of the relevant programs), and designated separately by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, after the date determined by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, or those who will complete the said program by March 31, 2015
- ⑦ Individuals who are designated by the Minister of Education, Culture and Sports, Science and Technology, as meeting the stipulation in the Ministry of Education Bulletin No.5, 1953 or those who will meet the stipulation by March 31, 2015

(2) Special selection for working adults

Individuals who belong to companies, governments, medical institutes, etc., who meet any of the conditions shown above (1) ①-⑦ and have at least three years of professional or industrial experience at the time of enrollment

(3) Special selection for foreign students

Individuals who are from foreign countries and meet any of the conditions shown above (1) ①-⑦.

The educational background shown below is also required for applicants for the Dual-Degree Program.

1. Successful completion of an introductory-level undergraduate computer science or information technology courses *
2. Demonstrated analytical ability, including the successful completion of undergraduate probability or statistics courses*
3. English proficiency for non-native speakers

*Items 1 & 2 can be compensated for with the appropriate professional or industrial experience.

2 Application Process

Application Process Complete the both application processes below.

1. Access to the online application system to complete the application forms and submit the necessary documents.
2. Submit the necessary documents in hard copy.

Application Period Dec. 1 (Mon.),2014 —Jan .6 (Tue .),2015

Completed application material must be received at University of Hyogo by Jan. 6 (Tue.) at the latest.

The GSAI accepts submission in person between 10:00-16:00 (closed 12:00-13:00). The office is not open on Saturdays, Sundays and national holidays.

* The online application system is accessible before Dec. 1 for you to prepare your applications. Be sure to submit your application by 16:00, Jan .6 (Tue .)

Selection Procedures

Applications will be evaluated by both CMU and University of Hyogo.

(If necessary, applicants might be interview by University of Hyogo.)

Successful applicants whose English language skills still need improvement for the CMU courses will be reviewed their TOEFL scores and academic achievement after admission into University of Hyogo.

Please note: applicants who fail to pass these reviews will not be allowed to attend the CMU classes at University of Hyogo, or to move to the U.S. to study at CMU.

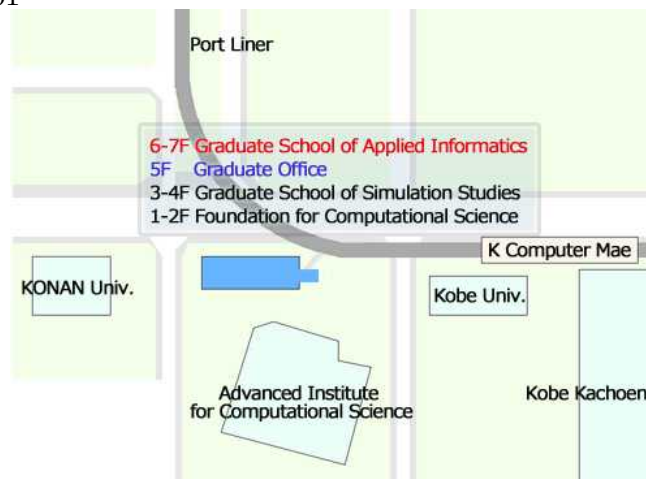
