履修上の注意・履修要件	<p>Students need to prepare for the next lesson, do the required homework, and review the previous lesson. It will be advantageous for most students to achieve a strong score on a standardized English test sometime while studying at university. Therefore, you are greatly encouraged to take one of these tests a few times before graduation. Probably, it would be beneficial to take it at least once during your first or second year, and then at least one more time during your third or fourth year. Of course, becoming aware of the format of the test by doing some practice test questions beforehand will be helpful.</p> <p>This class is scheduled to be conducted in person on campus.
