1. Number of positions:

2. Courses to be responsible

- (1) In addition to the above courses, the successful candidate will also be responsible for teaching various topic-based general education courses and sub-major program.
- (2) The courses to be responsible are subject to change after employment due to reorganization within the university.
- (3) The courses are included subjects in charge by two teachers.
- (4) Associate professors will be assigned to teach graduate school courses.

3. Eligibility requirements:

- (1) Doctoral degree (or equivalent education or research achievements) for Associate Professor, and Master's degree (or equivalent education or research achievements) for Senior Assistant Professor
- (2) Nursing license (to perform in a clinical setting in Japan under the Act on Public Health Nurses and Nurses)
- (3) Experience in perinatal care and education, and research activities

4. The candidate will have:

- (1) Research achievements in a specialized field and a strong passion for education and research
- (2) Ability to put front-line clinical experience to use in education and research
- (3) Promote the benefits of research, such as from industry-academia collaborations, to society

October 1, 2026 (*Employment start date is negotiable.)

6. Application procedures:

 - b. Research achievements (Form 2)
 - c. Educational history and activities in academic societies and society (Form 3)
 - d. Outline of major research so far (Form 4) in about 800 words
 - e. Aspirations for education and research (Form 5) in about 800 words
 - f. Full copies of major academic papers
 - g. Letter of recommendation (Free format) must be from department head or a person who can provide opinions on the field of specialty of the applicant. Also the letter must include the name and contact information of the person making the recommendation.
