Application Guidelines for a Full-time Position

The Research Institute of Nursing Care for People and Community at the University of Hyogo is calling for applicants for a full-time position in research and teaching. Prospective candidates are invited to submit applications in accordance with the following guidelines.

1. Number of Positions

2. Field of Specialization

3. Eligibility Requirements (Applicants should meet all of the following conditions.)
 - (1) A doctoral degree
 - (2) Teaching and research achievements in a relevant field
 - (3) If the applicant has a nursing license, we can evaluate the applicant.
4. The successful candidate will have:
 - (1) A strong desire to engage in creative new research in response to society's changing needs
 - (2) A global perspective, be highly motivated in practical activities and have the ability to take action
 - (3) A willingness to contribute to the development of nursing science.
 - (4) A proactive willingness to implement policy recommendations based on research outcomes
 - (5) A willingness to participate in activities that contribute to society such as through collaboration between industry and academia
 - (6) The ability to communicate in English
5. Job Starting Date
April 1, 2027
6. Term of Employment
Five (5) years
Based on the proposal of the president, the chairman of the executive board will approve re-appointment. In which case, the term of re-appointment shall be five years, the number of re-appointment shall be, in principle, one time with the upper limit being the retirement age (age 65). We have system for conversion to permanent faculty at the expiration of a term of office if the faculty meets specified requirements, such as particularly outstanding educational and research performance, etc.
7. Application Process
 - (1) Documents to be submitted *Please note that application materials will not be returned.
 - Resume (Form 1)
 - Research achievements (Form 2)
 - Educational history and activities in academic societies and society, etc.(Form 3)
 - Summary of significant research to date (Form 4)
 - Aspirations for education, research and social contribution (Form 5)
 - Reprints of significant papers (see Form 2-3)
 - 1 letter of recommendation (any format)
*The letter must be from the applicant's supervisor or a person able to provide opinions on the applicant's field of specialization. In addition, the letter must include the name and contact information of the person making the recommendation.
 - (2) Submission Instructions
 - Submit application materials in person or by post (Note: Please write "Teaching position application documents enclosed" in red ink on the envelope).

- (1) The screening will be based on application documents.
- (2) Applicants screened by submitted documents will be invited for an interview. Please note that no travel expenses will be provided.

※ Applicants will be notified promptly of the selection results after the selection.
