

Open Faculty Position (No.001), Graduate School of Information Science, University of Hyogo

The field of "AI for Science," which integrates deep learning, generative AI technologies, and High-Performance Computing (HPC) technologies, including GPU-accelerated computing, is rapidly advancing across computational science and data science.

Our Graduate School is establishing a new framework to advance research and education through the application of HPC and AI in respective specialized or interdisciplinary fields. Building upon our established collaborative research activities and education programs with the neighboring RIKEN Center for Computational Science (R-CCS), we seek to foster highly skilled doctoral researchers capable of leading the emerging field of "AI for Science". Beginning this academic year, we have also launched an English-taught lecture series, "Emerging Frontiers of AI/HPC for Science," in partnership with R-CCS. In addition, we are planning to establish a new globally oriented doctoral program, with the aim of attracting outstanding students and researchers from Japan and overseas.

Accordingly, we invite applications for a Professor position. The successful candidate will be expected to play a leading role in these initiatives and to demonstrate an outstanding record of research achievements, together with strong leadership and teaching capabilities. The appointee will be responsible for advancing research and education through the effective utilization of HPC and AI in their respective specialized or interdisciplinary fields.

1. Position title and the number of positions: One full-time professor

2. Affiliation: Graduate School of Information Science

3. Research field: Computational Science, Data Science, or Interdisciplinary Fields

4. Subjects to be assigned:

Master's program: Course basic and applied classes in either of computational science course or data science course, research supervision-related classes, and others

Doctoral program: Emerging Frontiers of AI/HPC for Science, lecture classes in the candidate's field of specialization, research supervision-related classes, and others

Undergraduate program: research supervision-related classes (upon requests from undergraduate students in the School of Social Information Science, University of Hyogo)

5. Start of employment: April 1, 2027

6. Qualification:

(1) Applicants must hold a Ph.D. or an equivalent doctoral degree and possess strong enthusiasm and commitment to the research and education described above.

(2) There are no restrictions on nationality. However, applicants must have sufficient Japanese language proficiency to carry out administrative and academic duties within the university.

(3) Applicants must have sufficient English language proficiency to conduct lectures and seminars in English.

7. Application documents:

9. Selection process: Screening of the documents and interview including a mock lecture. The interviewee has to pay his/her own travel expenses to attend the interview. Remote interviews will be permitted only for interviewees who reside outside Japan and are unable to travel to Japan.
